

IAN Scholarship Guidelines



IAN has a scholarship program to help defer the costs of workshops and increase professional development. These scholarships are available to all current members whose attendance would otherwise be limited due to financial restrictions.

For the calendar year of 2012, a total of \$800 has been allocated for scholarships. Scholarships are awarded up to \$100 and must be applied toward registration fees, food and/or lodging costs. Funds may not be applied toward payment of college credit, membership fees or travel expenses (examples include but not limited to fuel, airline tickets and meals during travel).

Applications deadlines are 40 days prior to the start of the scheduled workshop. The Scholarship Committee will make its decision and notify the applicants no later than 20 days prior to the start of the workshop. We understand there are extenuating circumstances and it will be handled in a case to case basis. In any case, to be reimbursed the applicant must provide itemized receipts to the chair, postmarked no later than 20 days after the workshop ends. After receiving an IAN scholarship, you are not eligible to reapply or receive another IAN scholarship for 24 months.

Selection of the recipients is based on the applicant's ability to explain the relevancy of the workshop to their career and/or professional goals. Student applicants must provide an endorsement from a university instructor or advisor.
